Verdicchio, Fazi Battaglia, Castelpiano, Italy \$9 \$34
Fresh with a floral perfume, hints of baked bread and almond.

Moscato, Mezzacorona, Italy \$9 \$34
Sweet, intense nose of tropical fruit with notes of nutmeg and cinnamon.

Pinot Grigio, Tolloy, Italy \$8 \$32
Delicate, cool and crisp bouquet. Classic and elegant feel, soft fruit unfolds on the palate.

Fresh Flight \$10

Sauvignon Blanc, Vermonte Reserva, Casablanca Valley, Chile \$7 \$24
Aromas of prickly citrus, nettle, cucumber and green fruits. Green apple, bell pepper and tarragon flavors.

Ugni Blanc-Colombard, Domaine Tariquet, Classic, France \$7 \$24
Crisp, aromas of ripe Granny Smith apples, fresh lime, white pepper, lime sorbet and minerals.

Verdicchio, Umani Ronchi, Italy \$8 \$32
Lively and balanced, nose of brioche, almonds and papaya. Creamy, hazelnuts, almonds and vanilla.

Rioja, Faustino, Rioja Reserva, Spain \$9 \$34
90% Tempranillo and 10% Mazuelo. Mature, smooth and very harmonious with soft, rounded tannins.

Malbec Blend, San Telmo, Argentina \$8 \$32
Strawberry and raspberry nose, with a little oak. Good cherry flavors with some woodiness and tartness, soft tannins.

Merlot, Casa Lapostole, Cuvee Alexander, Rapel Valley, Chile \$10 \$44
Nose of Morello cherries and dark chocolate. Long and still with plenty of fruit with notes of black pepper and cocoa.
